Attendance at Conciliation Conferences

Lawyers are reminded that your prompt attendance at conciliation conferences is required at the listed time.

If you are unable to attend a conference at the listed time, the Court requires at least 24 hours' notice to allow sufficient time to notify the conciliator engaged for the conference and to give all parties time to consider their position.

Requests for adjournments must be circulated to all parties by the practitioner making the request.

Court conciliators are engaged on an hourly basis, and so failures to attend on short notice, or delays, including to attend to a separate matter listed in Court at the same time, may result in increased costs for the Court. Your assistance in minimising these costs, and limiting cost and inconvenience to the parties, is appreciated.
