BICENTENARY OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TASMANIA

The first sitting of the Supreme Court of Van Diemen's Land was on 10 May 1824. A ceremonial sitting of the Supreme Court of Tasmania will take place at 11am on Friday 10 May 2024 in the No 1 Civil Court, Salamanca Place, Hobart, to commemorate the Court's bicentenary.

The proceedings will also be broadcast by video-link to the Launceston and Burnie Supreme Courts, for those practitioners who wish to attend in those locations.

All practitioners are invited to attend, and to robe. No wigs are to be worn.

In the foyer of the civil building after the ceremonial sitting, refreshments will be served and a book by the Hon Justice Stephen Estcourt AM entitled *From Convicts to Computers: Two Hundred Years of the Tasmanian Supreme Court* will be launched.
